

# Structure And Objective of the Society

## 1. INTRODUCTION

The Medical College and Hospital in the name of **Mahaveer Institute of Medical Sciences and Research (MIMS), Bhopal** is an institution promoted by the **Jain Sarvodaya Vidhya Gyanpith Samiti, Bhopal**, a society registered under **Madhya Pradesh Societies Registrickaran Adhiniyam 1973**, vide Reg. No. 01/01/0114826/05 dated 10.03.2005 as a charitable institution. It is a non-profit making charitable institution and the members of executive committee are experienced in their respective fields.

## 2. OBJECTIVE

To develop a 650 bedded General Hospital and Medical College with capacity to enroll 150 students per year.

## 3. VISION

Human Welfare leading to Physical, Mental & Intellectual upliftment by providing excellent Medical Education and Health services through Jain Sarvodaya Vidhya Gyanpith, a Charitable Society, consisting of eminent personalities from Medical, Political, Administrative, Judicial, Industry and other professional fields.

## 4. MISSION

To provide Medical related education and hospital services including research in the medical field by employing latest technology and expertise with state of art infrastructure and facilities. To serve the humanity by making healthcare accessible to common masses specially to most deprived sector of the society and provide medical professionals with in-depth knowledge, compassion and with sensitivity to human in line with the teachings of Lord Mahaveer.

## 5. LOCATION

The project is set up near the IT Park at Village Badwai, Tehsil Huzur, District Bhopal, and is easily accessible and connected by road, rail and air. The chosen site is situated in the municipal limits of Bhopal and is at a very strategic location.

## 6. TOTAL LAND AND AREA

The total land size is 25 acres as per MCI norm augurs well for the development of the medical college. The amended norms propose only 20 acres of land for medical college.

Size of the land is very good for future expansion and to provide other amenities. Creation of support areas will improve the image of the hospital in general public. Basic amenities like water, electricity, drainage system, etc. are easily available.

All the amenities are easily available as the plot is located in Village Badwai, Bhopal. It is situated adjacent to a 30 Mtr. wide Road which connects to a four-lane main road, and hence to-and-fro transportation is very easy.

MP has 13 medical colleges in the government sector and 7 in the private sector. Necessity of a medical college is governed by the total population of the state and based on the present population Madhya Pradesh should have at least 20 more medical colleges to cater to the demand.

## **7. SPECIAL FEATURES**

This is the first Medical College being set up by the Jain Society.

It has been facilitated positively by the Government of Madhya Pradesh by allotting 25 acres of land at a least rent of Rs. 1, in a prime location within the city.

The Government had issued permission to the Members of Legislative Assembly to use the MLA-LAD fund (up to Rs. 5 lakhs per MLA) to support this project.

The project envisages Mobile Hospital for day to day care to the people residing in remote areas.

Government authorized the Medical College to admit patients under Ayushman Bharat Yojana of the Government of India
